

MINUTES - Extraordinary meeting WAPs 7pm 23rd August 2012

Reason for the meeting:

A request had been made asking for a review of the age limit for a child to be able to participate in the pantomime. The request was that the limit be fixed by means of a school year rather than an age to avoid conflict between the children themselves. The committee recently met to discuss this and it was felt that as the original decision was made at the AGM it would not be proper for them to change that decision therefore an extraordinary meeting was called for.

11 people attended the meeting. A further proposal was put forward at the meeting, which is featured at number 3 below.

1. The original decision was: *A child may take part if it is 9 years of age on or before the first day of the pantomime.*

2. The new proposal was: *A child may take part if it is in school year 4 or above on the first day of the pantomime.*

3. The further proposal was: *A child may take part if it is in school year 5 or above on the first day of the pantomime.*

A vote was taken to change from an age to a school year and that was agreed.

A further vote was then taken on the other 2 proposals and the results were:

Year 5 - 6 votes

Year 4 - 4 votes

Abstentions - 2

The decision therefore is that a child may take part in the Pantomime if it is in year 5 on the first day of the Pantomime.
